The year before, we had had 39 kids registered for the club. Last year we only had 13 registrations, and only about 8 to 10 kids who attended regularly. I don't mind having a smaller club, but I wondered why the decline. We began praying for the club and for helpers. God supplied both. There were 25 kids the first week, and now about 30. One little girl had asked her grandmother to come to the first club. The grandmother did come and seemed to enjoy it as much as the kids did.

The first club of the year, a little girl came in with a big smile and told me she could hardly wait for Good News Club to start. We started with snack, and she jumped up and came over about five times to tell me that she loves Good News Club! I thought it might wear off after the first club, but she continues to tell me as soon as she gets there that she loves GNC.

The missionary story is about **Lottie D. Moon.** I love it when I get to the end of the chapter for that week, and the cliffhanger; and the kids say, "Oh, no, we have to wait till next week to find

out what happens!" It is amazing how much they remember from week to week. They are also learning a lot about North Korea and are praying for them to be able to have GNCs there.
